The <u>Feeding Knowledge Program</u> is one of the initiatives of the International Centre for <u>Advanced</u> <u>Mediterranean Agronomic Studies CIHEAM</u>.

The Feeding Knowledge Program in collaboration with Expo Milano 2015 launched a call aimed at the recognition and promotion of *Best Sustainable Development Practices on Food Security (BSDP)*. The Program aims to establish an international scientific network for research and innovation to promote and transfer knowledge on food security.

The National Catalogue of Innovations for Human Development in Albania has been realized in 2012 by the Albanian Agency for Research, Technology and Innovation AKTI, the BAZH NGO, the UNDP Programme for Governance and Local Development and IDEASS. More than 160 national actors, such as ministers, universities, specialized centres, territorial organizations and local governments participated in this initiative.

In 2014, the Ministry of Public Administration and Innovation of Albania invited the authors of the National Catalogue to present their respective innovations during the prestigious national *Innovation Week*.
