

FIRST LATIN AMERICA MEETING OF YOUNG MILK PRODUCERS

[Pan-American Dairy Federation FEPALE](#) and National Association of Milk Producers ANPL of Uruguay will gather the youth of the continent in the first Pan-American Meeting of Young Milk Producers.

The event, which will take place from 23rd to 25th September 2013 in the city of Colonia, Uruguay, aims at gathering young people (18-30 years old) connected with milk production and coming from the whole continent, for them to exchange knowledge and experiences. The initiative is significantly contributing to the promotion of milk-related professions among young people, considering that milk is a basic food for the continent population.



The Pan-American Dairy Federation FEPALE was created in 1991, following the decision taken by Pan-American Congress of Milk to form an organization that could gather American milk producers. The main role of the Federation is to support the interests of the different links of milk value chain. FEPALE gathers all the stakeholders of the sector: producers, dealers, industrialists, sellers, researchers, educators, government, private sector and others. In particular, FEPALE works for increasing the availability and the consumption of milk produced in the region.

The venue of FEPALE is in Montevideo, Uruguay, where its General Secretariat works for developing different technical activities and activities of coordination and representation. In the General Secretariat the Pan-American System of Milk Information INFOLECHE and the Training Area of FEPALE also work, realizing important initiatives of integral capacity-building in the different links of milk value chain.
