 of precision farming and use of Internet-of-Things in agriculture.
 Circular economy, Internet of things Cross-cutting activities
- Greening the economy, climate action, environment, resource efficiency and raw materials <u>Societal Challenge 5</u>

From 24 to 27 November, the European Commission will organise an InfoWeek on Societal Challenge 2 calls 2016 with a special workshop on multi-actor projects.
