

WINNERS & FINALISTS OF THE 21ST EDITION ENERGY GLOBE WORLD AWARD

In June 2021, the Energy Globe Foundation [announced the winners and finalists of the 21st Energy Globe World Award](#). The objective of the Energy Globe Award is to present successful sustainable projects to a global audience and to demonstrate that for most of our environmental problems feasible solutions are already available.



With more than 187 participating countries, the Energy Globe Award is a prestigious environmental prize worldwide. The Award is presented in the categories of Life: Earth, Fire, Water, Air, and the future-oriented category Youth.

The Energy Globe Award [has been organized since 1999 by the Energy Globe Foundation from Austria](#). The aim is to raise global attention and to motivate people to become active on sustainable, globally appropriate environmental solutions, ranging from high-tech to simple but highly efficient ones. Eligible for participation are projects with a focus on saving resources, improving air, soil, or water quality, increasing energy efficiency, using renewable resources, as well as all those giving a contribution towards the fight against climate change.

The Energy Globe Award has already opened the [application for the 2022 edition](#). Innovative projects and smart technologies which save our environment from around the world are invited



to submit. International winning projects for each category will receive a cash award (2000 €) and will be honored as part of a ceremony that will be broadcast worldwide as well as featured in the international media.

The categories of the new edition are Earth, Fire, Water, Air, Youth and the new special category Sustainable Start-Up. Cooperation partner in this new special category is the United Nations Agency UNIDO. Every individual, private or public institution, company or NGO can submit one or multiple projects. The participation is free of charge.
