

## THE WINNERS OF THE 9TH EDITION OF THE GREEN LATIN AMERICA AWARDS 2023

In April 2023, [the winners of the 2023 edition of the Lainoamerica Verde Awards were celebrated](#). The winning projects of the 2023 Edition are being developed in Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Chile, Mexico, Brazil, Spain, Honduras, Argentina, Bolivia, Switzerland, Guatemala, and the United States. The initiative's website presents a description of each of the projects and provides the email addresses of people with whom to establish contacts for information and possible collaborations.



The Green Latin America Awards are open to projects from governments, organizations, companies and microbusinesses, communities, individuals and NGOs. Since the first edition, in 2013, the growth in participation in the Awards has been exponential. Nearly 18,000 candidates from 43 countries took part in past editions.

[Launched in 2013 in Guayaquil \(Ecuador\), the Green Latin America Awards Initiative](#) seeks to be a showcase that contributes to energizing the region's green economy by exhibiting initiatives in categories aligned with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). . A high-level jury, which includes among others the United Nations Development Program UNDP and UN Environment, evaluates all the projects received and chooses the best in each category to name the winners. Every year the initiative rewards, gives visibility and creates networks among the best 500 social and environmental projects in Latin America. The winning projects, in addition to obtaining an Award certificate with the general ranking and the specific category and participating in the award events, can have access to mentoring, training programs for sustainable entrepreneurship, and spaces of co-creation and business conferences.

The Awards focus on various areas to develop a sustainable world. The main topics are: Biodiversity, Green cities, Communication, Human development, Circular economy, Energy for all, Public policies, Waste Management.

[The website presents a Virtual Gallery of all the 500 winning projects of the Green Latin America Awards](#). The website also presents the [2023 Impact Report Study](#) produced with the results of the Latin America Green Awards in the countries. To prepare the report, the work was divided into 2 phases: the Survey carried out on the ranking of the 500 best projects, finalists and winners of the last ten editions (Total: 3000 projects from 2013 to 2022) and the interviews with the leaders of three participating projects from previous editions, a coordinator, a specialized jury and a representative of the Green Awards technical commission. This extraordinary demonstrates the impact that the award-winning projects have managed to produce in the countries and offers an extraordinary



panorama of the capacity and creativity of the actors who carry out innovative practices for sustainable development in the countries of Ibero-America.
